

Greensborough College Uniform



The **Academic Uniform** is a wardrobe that suits Melbourne's variable weather - students may wear uniform pieces that suit current weather conditions and comfort level, whilst maintaining high standards of pride and neatness in their presentation.

The Academic Uniform can be worn on all school days unless the student has Physical Education class.

- Shoes to be worn are black, leather, lace up school shoes
- White socks are to be worn with the shorts, skirt or dress
- Dark socks are to be worn with the pants
- The soft shell jacket and rugby top can be worn with academic uniform.

Leather runners, Mary Janes, T-Bars etc are not accepted



The **Physical Education Uniform (PE)** can be worn on any day excluding school photo day, award ceremonies and any other day as advised by the Principal Team.

- **White sports socks are to be worn with the PE uniform**
- Runners are to be worn
- The PE uniform can be worn with the soft shell jacket or rugby top.
- Navy shorts, trousers or cuffed track pants must not have any branded logos. The only permitted logo is the college logo.



Approved Optional Accessories that can be worn are;

- Greensborough College beanie, cap or bucket hat with logo.
- Greensborough College scarf with logo

No other accessories are approved.



The Approved Bags are;

- Greensborough College school bag with logo
- Greensborough College satchel with logo

No other bags are approved.

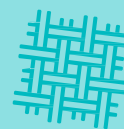
1. RECYCLED PLASTICS

SHORTS & TROUSERS

Shorts and trousers now feature 30% Recycled PET plastic. Over the past 2 years Noone has extensively tested the durability of Recycled PET in comparison to virgin polyester. Whilst fibre strength was the same, the pill rating from Recycled PET fabrics was inferior to virgin polyester. Therefore, Noone has adopted a mix of virgin polyester and recycled polyester with 35% viscose and 2 % elastane (for stretch and comfort) to ensure the quality of our shorts and pants achieve the highest quality standards. Our commitment to sustainability will not be at the compromise of quality or durability.



BLAZERS

Blazers all now feature recycled polyester blazer lining, fusing, buttons, thread, canvas chest piece and wadding.

Wool blend fabrics for blazers will now feature recycled polyester from 2023.



WOOL & COTTON

Noone remains committed to the use of natural fibres such as wool and cotton. Both of these fibres are bio-degradable and is adopted in many uniform items from blazers, shirts, pullovers, skirts, dresses and shorts / trousers.
