



Greensborough College Scholarship Application

We strongly encourage all students to read through the various scholarships on offer and to apply for one that speaks to your strengths and interests. The application process is a great way to showcase your aspirations and goals for secondary college.

Incoming Year 7 students may apply for the Academic Excellence, Arts, Community & Leadership, and Sporting Excellence Scholarships. A description for each of these four scholarships is listed under the Scholarships section of the Greensborough College website.

Submission must include a letter addressed to the school that explains the student's eligibility and suitability for their chosen scholarship, and incorporate some, or all, of the four school values in their response: Courage, Aspiration, Respect, and Equality. The letter should also include a brief student profile on themselves listing hobbies, interests, academic strengths and weaknesses, extra-curricular activities, past leadership positions, community service, etc.

Entries should be roughly a page or two in length. Students are welcome to apply for more than one scholarship if they feel they are suitably eligible.

In addition to their application letter, submissions must also attach the following supporting document:

- A short letter of recommendation from their Grade 6 teacher, specialist Art/Music teacher, or PE teacher/sporting coach (dependent on which scholarship you are applying for) referring to the relevant skills, qualities and attributes you have shown in that area throughout your Primary School life.
- A copy of their most recent school report

If both the application letter and supporting documents are not submitted to the school email address before the closing date, the application will not be accepted.

Send application letters and supporting materials to greensborough.sc@education.vic.gov.au by close of business Monday October 6th, 2025.

All scholarships are for one year and attract a \$250 credit to family accounts that can be used on school contributions, programs or events. The scholarship recipient will also receive a gift youcher and a certificate.
