- A student profile on themselves (hobbies, interests, academic strengths and weaknesses, extra-curricular activities, past leadership positions, community service, etc.)
- A letter of recommendation from their Grade 6 teacher, specialist Music or PE teacher (dependent on which scholarship you are applying for) referring to the skills, qualities and attributes you have shown in that area throughout your Primary School life
- A copy of their most recent school report

If supporting documents are not submitted to the school email address prior to the closing date the application will not be accepted.

**Please note:** If shortlisted, you may be required to attend an Interview. A parent/guardian must accompany the student at the interview if shortlisted. All Shortlisted applicants will be contacted to arrange a suitable time for the interview. A requirement of the selection criteria is contact with the student's current Primary School. By submitting the application form parents agree to abide by the decision of the College.
