



Academic Uniform and Sports Uniform

The College uniform is a visible sign of the school as an entity. The wearing of the College uniform encourages confidence and pride in oneself as an individual and identifies the student as a member of the College Community. Students seeking to enrol at Greensborough College agree to accept the responsibility to wear the school uniform on all occasions as approved by the College Council.

At Greensborough College we pride ourselves on the school uniform. It is compulsory for students to wear the Greensborough College Uniform in the correct manner and time depending on what students are studying on any particular day. Students not conforming to these rules will be considered “out of uniform” and subject to escalating consequences.

College New Uniform Information

- In 2020 we have a new uniform which is compulsory for all Year 7 students and any new student to the school.
- All current students are required to wear the new uniform from the beginning of 2022.
- Soft Shell Jacket may be worn with the new and old uniform during the transition.
- Flexibility and choice in the wardrobe.

General appearance

- Uniforms should be worn correctly according to the description in the table overleaf. The information provided in this table also covers the way uniform is to be worn on the way to or from school.
- Shirts should be buttoned up at all times.
- No garments from the regular school uniform list may be worn with the PE uniform except for the soft shell jacket.
- Uniforms should not be worn in inappropriate sizes e.g. not over size.
- Students are expected to be neat in appearance at all times.
- Uniforms should be clean and in good repair.
- Black leather shoes should be polished regularly.
- In the interest of personal and public health, students are expected to show high standards of personal hygiene.

Make-up and other changes to personal appearance

- Make-up and nail polish, if worn at all, should be unobtrusive and appropriate to the school environment. i.e Nail polish (if worn) should be either clear or 'nude' in colouration.
- Hair: Artificial hair colours are permitted. Colours that do not naturally occur in the population (bright red, pink, green, blue etc) are not permitted.

Shoes

All students must wear traditional black leather lace-up school shoes when wearing the Academic Uniform (T Bar style shoes are not permitted).

Sport Shoes (Runners) may be worn to and from school with correct PE uniform in accordance with guidelines specified.

Approved accessories

Acceptable accessories for both boys and girls are:

- One wrist watch and one plain, small ring; to be removed for PE and Technology classes.
- Up to TWO traditional ear studs or sleeper style earrings per ear. **Studs, spacers, rings or bolts (or any similar jewellery) are not to be worn in any other visible part of the body, including nose eyebrows, tongue or lip. Retainers are not acceptable.**
- Navy blue College school bag with logo or plain blue school type bag with no markings at all. Light-weight excursion bags can be purchased for \$2 for students going on an excursion.
- Scarf with school logo.
- Cap/Beanie with school logo.
- Hair ties/bands etc. must be navy blue, black or white and must be modest in size.

Four important points to note:

- Dress/skirt length to sit on the knee when standing.
- No other jewellery or accessories are approved.
- The only items of outer (visible) clothing to be worn are those included in the official Greensborough College uniform list.
- PE uniform may only be worn on days of timetabled practical PE classes or on scheduled sporting activities.

1	GC	Dress	Dress length is to sit on the knee when standing. Any garment worn under the dress must not be visible at the neckline or below the sleeve.
2	GC	Navy Shorts - Tailored Navy Shorts - Loose cut	Worn with ankle length white socks (must sit 4cm above the ankle) and black leather lace up school shoes.
3	GC	Shirt - Short Sleeve tailored or straight cut Shirt - Long Sleeve tailored or straight cut	
4	GC	Navy Slacks - tailored wool blend Navy Trousers - loose cut, flat front	Worn with black leather lace up school shoes.
5	GC	Navy Skirt	Skirt length is to sit on the knee when standing. Any garment worn under the skirt must not be visible.
6	GC	Cardigan	To be worn only with Academic Uniform.
7	GC	Pullover	To be worn only with Academic Uniform.
8	GC	Soft Shell Jacket	Can be worn with Academic Uniform or PE Uniform. Can be worn with previous school uniform during the transition period.
9	GC	Blazer	Optional - to be worn only with Academic Uniform.
10	GC	School Tie	Optional – to be worn appropriately.
11		Tights	Navy Tights – must be 70 denier thickness. Appropriate tights are available from the Uniform Supplier. Tights must not be worn with socks.
12		Socks	Plain white socks - ankle length (must sit 4cm above the ankle). Available from the Uniform Supplier. No sports brand logos.

1	GC	PE Top – Short Sleeve PE Top – Long Sleeve	Compulsory in Years 7-10. Year 11 and 12 for any practical PE Class. All year levels competing interschool sport.
2	GC	Sports Short – stretch microfiber Sports Short – stretch microfiber with built in brief	Compulsory in Years 7-10. Year 11 and 12 for any practical PE Class. All year levels competing interschool sport.
3	GC	Tracksuit Pants	Compulsory in Years 7-10. Year 11 and 12 for any practical PE Class. All year levels competing interschool sport.
4	GC	Soft Shell Jacket	Can be worn with Academic Uniform or PE Uniform. Can be worn with previous school uniform during the transition period.
5	GC	ADP Training Singlet	Only for ADP Training Sessions.
6		Sport Socks	White Sport Socks – no sports brand logos.

Accessories

1	GC	Greensborough College School Bag	Official GC School Bag or plain Navy School Bag (no logos).
2	GC	Cap	Can be worn with Academic Uniform or PE Uniform. Worn appropriately – not to be worn indoors.
3	GC	Beanie	Can be worn with Academic Uniform or PE Uniform. Worn appropriately - not to be worn indoors.
4	GC	Scarf	Can be worn with Academic Uniform or PE Uniform.
5	GC	Greensborough College Year 12 Jacket	Year 12 only. Can be worn with Academic Uniform or PE Uniform.
